### **100<sup>th</sup> ANNIVERSARY OF FATIMA**

This year marks the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Marian Apparition at Fatima, Portugal. On May 13<sup>th</sup>, 1917 Mary began appearing to three young children and continued to do so each month until October of that same year. On May 13<sup>th</sup> of this year Pope Francis will canonize two of the three children, Francisco and Jacinta, both of whom died just a few years after the apparitions. The 3<sup>rd</sup>, Lucia, became a nun and lived to the age of 97, having just died 12 years ago in 2005.

On **Friday evening, May 12<sup>th</sup>** Deacon Enrico will lead an evening in honor of this great event in the church. The schedule will be as follows:

**7-7:30pm:** Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament with the recitation of the Rosary.

**7:30-8:30pm:** Watch the DVD of Finding Fatima

**8:30-8:45pm:** Discussion/Witnessing to the Blessed Mother's presence in our lives.
